


#### LUKE 4:1-2 NIV

Jesus, full of the Holy Spirit, left the Jordan and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness,



### LUKE 4:3 DIV 3 The devil said to him, "If you are the Son of God, tell this stone to become bread."




#### AS WE SEE HOW SATAN TEMPTED <u>Jesus,</u> We gan conclude some things about How he tempts <u>us</u>.

#### AS WE SEE HOW SATAN TEMPTED <u>Jesus</u>, We can conclude some things about How he tempts <u>us</u>.


3. He tempts us to <u>pursue becoming</u> something outside the Father's will.



## FIVE VERY COMMON <u>SEASONS</u> OF LIFE WHEN WE ARE PRONE TO TEMPTATION.


1. When we are <u>alone</u>



GENESIS 39:11 NIV 11 One day he went into the house to attend to his duties, and none of the household servants was inside.








#### 1 KINGS 39:3-5 NIV




#### LUKE 3:21-22 NIV
